

BRNHA Signage Program



The signs are shipped in their frames and boxed in similar sized boxes that one person can move. The 2 legs of the bases are shipped in a separate box. They are in the boxes behind her to the right and the ones with baseplates are wrapped in foam and leaning against the wall on left side of picture.



The signs are wrapped in a layer of foam, then boxed. Each box is labeled with the DOT Division and sign number for efficiency in loading for the installation.



Above: There are 14-15 boxes on each pallet



Left: Each leg is wrapped in foam and the 2 legs are next to each other with the angled sides on opposite ends of the box. There is a lot of empty space in the box. It is light, but large and a bit cumbersome to move with one person.



All the sign boxes are numbered and organized against the wall.
